CHRISTOPHER C. GIBBS (Wiesenthal, Co-Producer) first appeared on stage in 1961. Since then he has performed in over 80 plays, musicals (dancing!) and operas. (OK, only one opera.) After serving with the US Army for 18 months in Viet Nam, he attended graduate school, receiving his doctorate in History in 1980. He taught college for over 30 years, with occasional forays on stage. He retired from teaching five years ago to pursue acting full time. He is the author of eight books, including six crime novels in the Highland County Mystery series, several case studies for Harvard Business School, and articles on various aspects of American History for scholarly journals. Among his favorite roles are Lear,

Malvolio, Ernst Janning (*Judgment at Nuremberg*), Beverly (*August: Osage County*, directed by Mark Liebert), Otto Frank, Atticus Finch, and Wilder's Stage Manager. He is passionately committed to the message contained in Tom Dugan's wonderful play about Simon Wiesenthal.

MARK LIEBERT (Director, Co-Producer, Designer) has directed more than 30 shows over the last twenty years including the New jersey premiers of "Appropriate" and "August Osage County". He began acting in 1960 and at 11 made his professional debut. High lights of his early career included the world premier of "A White House Happening" with Jon Lithgow and Tommy Lee Jones. In 1972 he joined "One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest" which began a three year association with the show which included stints in Boston, NY, SF, and two tours. There were also numerous film and television credits. In 1979 he became a Physical Therapist, but returned to theatre in 1994 and has worked at numerous NY and NJ theaters. He appeared in more than 35 different productions, designed sets for more than 70 shows and written several plays. Mark serves on the Board of Managers of Studio Players in Upper Montclair, NJ. He also created a theatre program for multiply-disabled children. Awards include: ASAH Related Services Provider of the Year 2009; NJ School Boards 2011 Award for Innovations in Special Education: NJ Theatre Alliance/NJ Council on the Arts Cultural Access Network Project Innovator Award for 2012-13. As always he is grateful to work with the talented and generous Christopher Gibbs, Judi Liebert, Josh Liebert, and Ben Liebert. Never Forget. Albert.

JUDI LIEBERT (Stage Manager) Behind the scenes per usual, Judi is thrilled to be working with Mark and Chris on such an important show. 
